# 11<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL KINDNESS WEEK LAUNCHES IN ACCORA VILLAGE Performance from The Big Bucket Band, a surprise Kindness Award, and more!

**Thursday, February 15, 2018, OTTAWA, ON** — The 11<sup>th</sup> annual <u>Kindness Week (February 16 - 23)</u> will be launched tomorrow at Accora Village. Special guests include Rabbi Reuven Bulka, Ottawa Mayor Jim Watson, Ottawa South MPP John Fraser, Ottawa West-Nepean MPP Bob Chiarelli, Bay Ward City Councillor Mark Taylor, and Dan Greenberg, Vice President of Ferguslea Properties Ltd. The program features a performance by the Big Bucket Band and will be emceed by CTV's Terry Marcotte.

To celebrate this year's theme of Kinds of Kindness, Rabbi Bulka will also honour a guest with an extra-special **surprise Kindness Award.** Beyond the launch event, the Kindness Committee will be surprising individuals and groups all week long with Kindness Awards for their everyday acts of kindness.
